Amidst a sunny day in Washington, D.C. Col. Edwin P. Ramsey, 26th Cavalry, PS was laid to rest at Arlington National Cemetery on June 28, 2013. Dr. Raquel Ramsey is steadfast in telling the story of this extraordinary family and persevere their legacy. LT Col Ramsey was born in Illinois and graduated from Oklahoma Military Academy. He volunteered to serve with the 26th Cavalry of the Philippine Scouts, and after Japan invaded the Philippines, Ramsey escaped to mobilize and later lead as many as 40,000 guerrilla fighters in central Luzon.

In January 1942 on Bataan, he led the last mounted U.S. Army Horse Cavalry charge, for which he received the Silver Star. In June 1945 Gen. Douglas MacArthur pinned the Distinguished Service Cross on Lt. Col. Ramsey.

Raquel is the Executive Producer of Never Surrender: The Ed Ramsey Story. Upon her husband's request to write his sister's book, she embarked on the project and became an archivist, historian and writer of Taking Flight: The Nadine Ramsey Story, which will be published in Oct 2020 by the University of Kansas Press."
