Ramsey joined in 1943 and graduated in class 43-5. As a WASP, Ramsey piloted PT-19, BT-13, UC-78, AT-6, P-39, P-47, P-51, and P-63 planes. She was also one of the twenty-six WASPs who flew a Lockheed P-38 Lightning. Stationed at Long Beach Army Air Field, she ferried military planes across the country as part of the Army's Sixth Ferrying Group. After the WASPs were disbanded, Ramsey remained on the base as a preflight instructor. She and other WASPs were formally given veteran status in 1977 retroactively, and in 2010 were awarded a Congressional Gold Medal – posthumously for Ramsey and most of her wartime comrades.
